The 11th season of the Voorheesville Farmer's Market begins on Wednesday, June 19, 2019. If not for our faithful and great vendors, our market would not exist, so thank you for your participation and support during these past ten years.

The 2019 market will run for 16 weeks. Our last market day will be Wednesday, October 2. The fee for the market this season is \$150 for a 10 x 10 space. The fee for a biweekly spot is \$100. A deposit of \$20 is due by April 15th to hold your spot. The remaining balance will be due on the third week of the market (Wednesday, July 10).

A \$5 gift coupon will be given away each week to one customer to use at whatever vendor they choose. The coupon will be provided by the market and the vendor will be reimbursed upon turning in the coupon to market staff. We are planning to have several weeks with music, special dinners, face painting and balloon twisting for the kids, as well as an old favorite, TCBY yogurt.

2019 Rules & Regulations*



1. The Farmer's Market will operate on Wednesdays from June 19 - October 2 from 3:30-6:30 p.m.
2. No selling or bagging may occur until 3:30.
3. No one should dismantle their booth **until 6:30 pm.**
4. Sellers must have their market sites dismantled, packed up, and cleaned within one hour of the market closure.
5. 80% of the products offered for sale must be produced by the seller on lands or in production facilities they own or operate. If a farmer grows fruits and vegetables, another producer can't buy those products for resale.
6. Bedding plants, nursery products, and cut flowers must be grown on your farm.
7. Sellers must have a sign clearly showing their name.
8. Each seller will be responsible for all equipment and supplies for the setup of a booth. Displays should be constructed in a way that they do not block customer walkways or pose any other hazard to customers.
9. Vendors who provide samples and/or products that will result in waste material, such as cups, rinds, and corn cobs, must provide containers for waste disposal.
10. All vendors, without exception, must provide proof of general liability and product liability insurance of \$1 million each. The market should be listed as an additional insured. A copy of the insurance certificate must be given to the market manager prior to setting up or selling any products at the market.
11. Sellers must notify the market manager in advance if they will be absent
12. **You must have weights and ropes to tie down tents in case of high winds. If you don't have weights, you will not be allowed to put up your tent.**
13. **NO styrofoam** allowed. All containers must be recyclable.
